Since 1919, Americans have observed November 11th as a day to honor the sacrifices of those who have fought for freedom. Originally called Armistice Day, President Wilson first declared November 11th a day of remembrance following the end of hostilities between the Allied Nations and Germany in World War I on November 11, 1918.
